WASHINGTON, D.C. (March 3rd, 2022) – With lawmakers in Washington [proposing measures](#) aimed at reducing America’s dependence on foreign sources of energy, the Residential Renewables for All campaign today issued the following statement calling on Congress to support home-grown renewable energy:

“The current disruptions in the international energy markets are a painful reminder that the best way to promote America’s energy independence and protect American families is to accelerate our transition to clean, home-grown sources of renewable energy. After months of negotiations, lawmakers were on the verge of passing the most transformative effort to achieve energy independence, combat climate change, and advance environmental justice in generations. The legislation included a key tax provision that would spark a local clean energy revolution and reduce our nation’s dependence on fossil fuels. Even now, as the current geopolitical crisis demands a shift towards domestic clean energy as a matter of vital national interest, lawmakers are still sitting on their thumbs. In the meantime, hardworking Americans are feeling the pinch—gas and energy prices are soaring on top of already sky-high inflation. Americans cannot afford to wait any longer. Residential Renewables for All strongly urges lawmakers to deliver this legislation to the President’s desk as soon as possible. Our country’s energy independence depends on it.”
